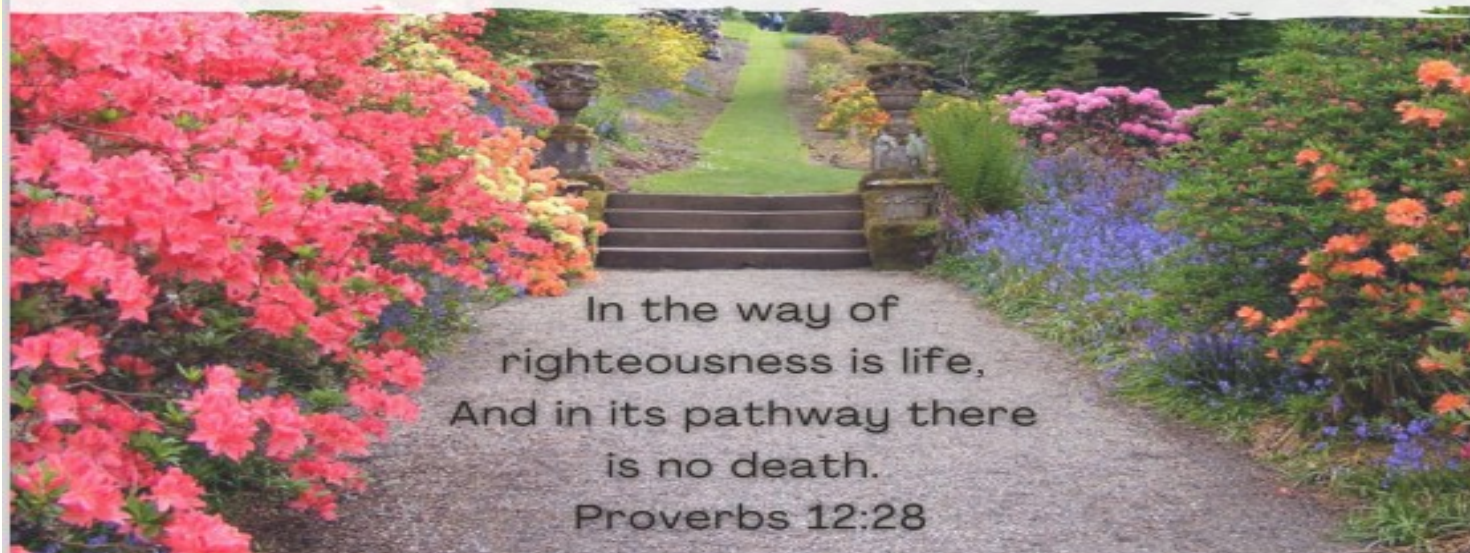

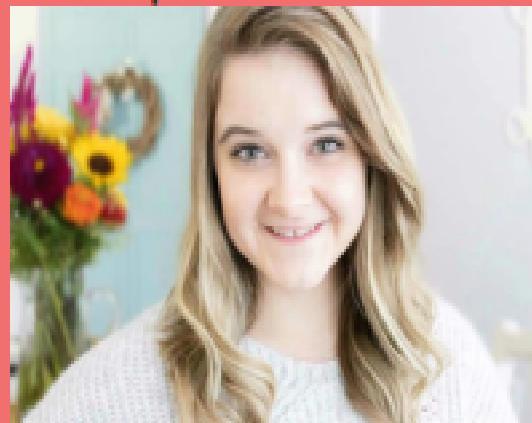


## Speaker: Jodi Aiken
