I.	Financial boost as an encouragement to help an individual or group meet financial goals toward going on mission	Up to \$1,000	As for a scholarship, this is for one application per person or group.
	Ex: cost of passport application; ticket		Apply once per year, or please offer a compelling need.
II.	Provision to meet physical needs such as the need for equipment or to achieve safety guidelines	Up to \$1,000	One application per person, group, or project
	Ex: generator; treated lumber for ramp; service and upgrades to the Association's disaster relief trailer		Apply once per year, or please offer a compelling need.
III.	Training and Project support to help meet a ministry or outreach goal	Up to \$1,000	One application per person, group, or project
	Ex: costs associated with receiving training, fulfill quota in packing book bags; need for additional sneakers; need for gas money to deliver mission materials or donations		Apply once per year, or please offer a compelling need.

I.	Baptist Men	Do Baptist Men's groups in individual churches o have an aspirational goal and seek partners and want contacts and connections? o desire training in a specific area where we could band together?	The Baptist Convention in NM has a menu of partnership opportunities for evangelism and revitalization efforts. An example is an opportunity for cooking at a Christian-based summer camp.
II.	Church Planting helping with Revitalization	Do our pastors and churches see an opening for church planting in the next 3 years? 5 years?	Research shows that the most people coming to Christ are doing so through the work of <i>new</i> and church plant churches.
III.	Disaster Recovery	How can we continue to help long term and short-term needs in WNC? What do we anticipate are needs in 6 months? 12 months? 2 years? Consider the implications of federal grant and funding streams <i>closing</i> . For example, if coverage for school breakfasts and school lunches is cut, we may have unprecedented local need.	Our Association has a reasonably well-stocked disaster response trailer & generator that were serviced in the fall of 2024. The trailer is ready for road travel but not for off-road or mud/snow travel.
IV.	Evangelism	Knowing we are to win the lost to Christ, make disciples, fellowship & break bread together, worship God, and care for widows & orphans, where is God working and how can we come alongside?	This is an emphasis for all teams throughout the SCBA. How can we operate as a think-tank that activates?
V.	WMU	Do ladies or girls' groups in individual churches o have an aspirational goal and seek partners and want contacts and connections? o desire training in a specific area where we could band together?	
VI.	Building Networks & Messaging	How can we build networks that reach & activate lay church workers?	Our SCBA newsletter is terrific, but pastors are saturated. Let's reach the <i>other</i> workers remembering that not every church has a secretary.
